LAKE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

DLSD agreed to fund pellet program with the Town provided the Town Lake Committee petitions neighboring communities (City of Elkhorn, City of Delavan, and Town of Walworth) for contributions.

Winter rain event and fast thaw caused the lake to rise to over 928.50. Only two gates are operational at this time.

Conveyors reconditioned for summer use, harvesters getting wrapped up in March and April.

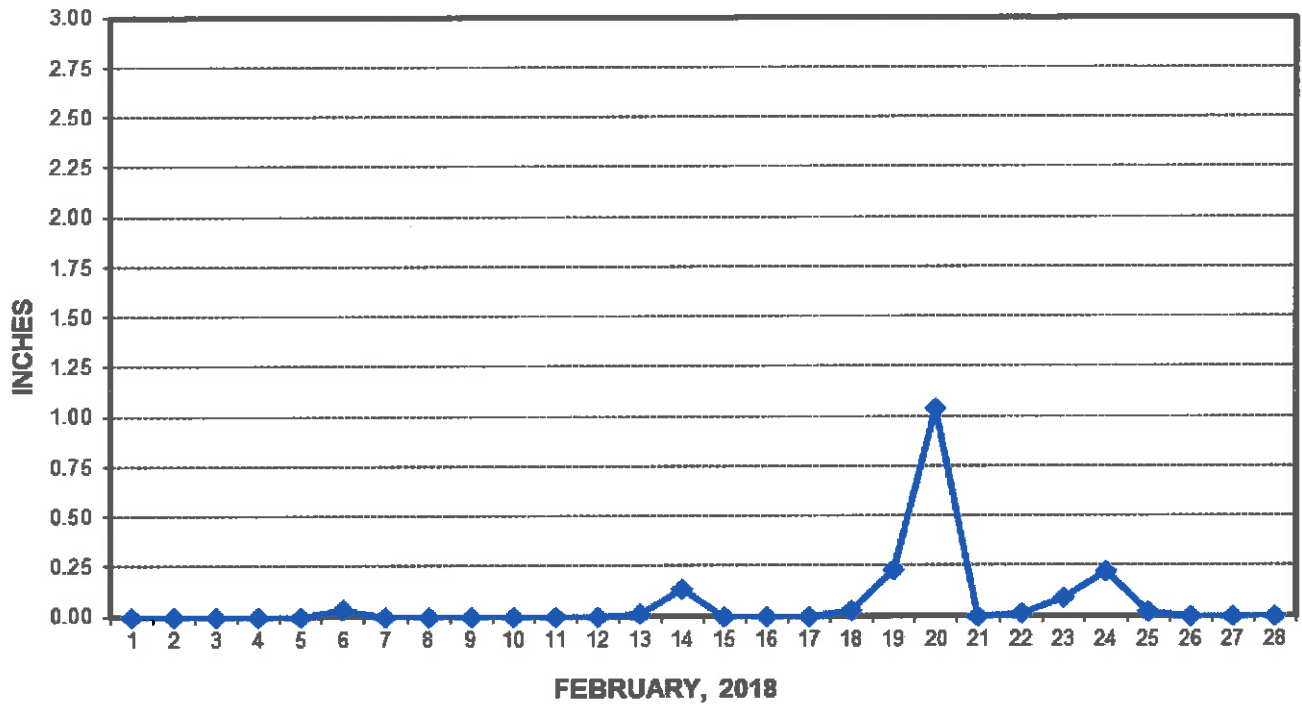
New Harvester and Conveyor are in production.

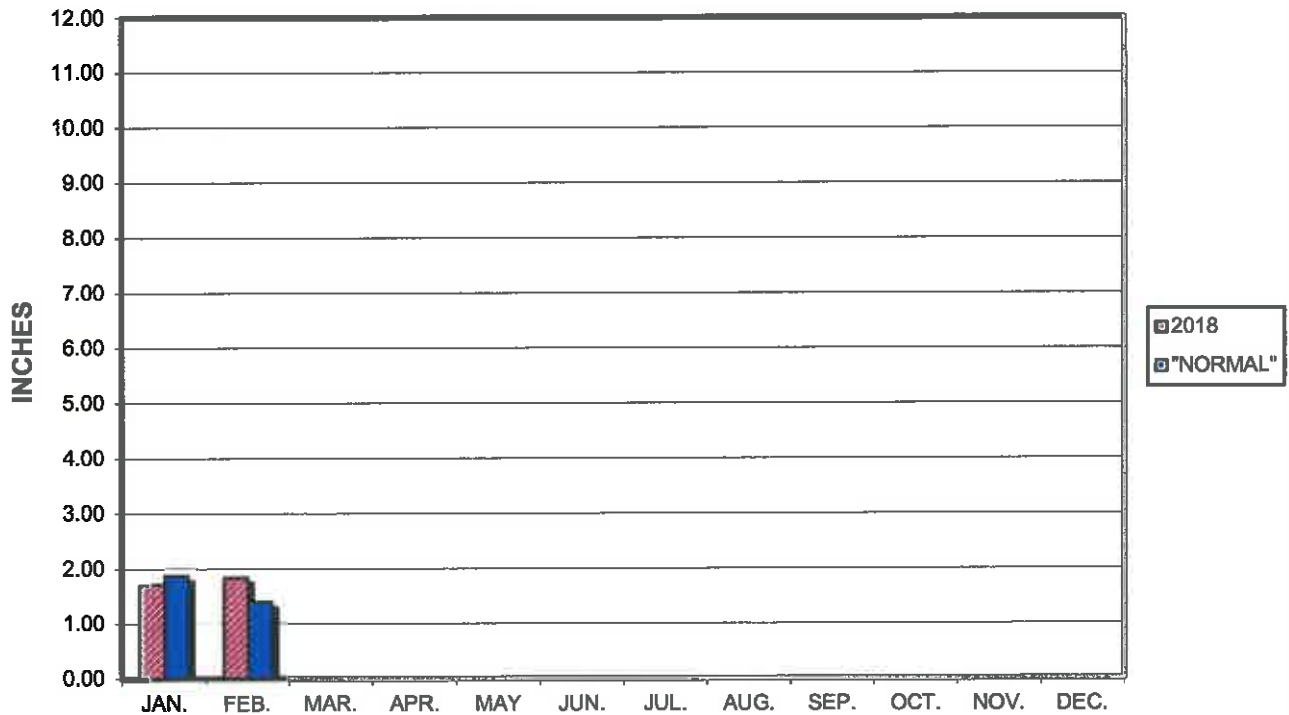

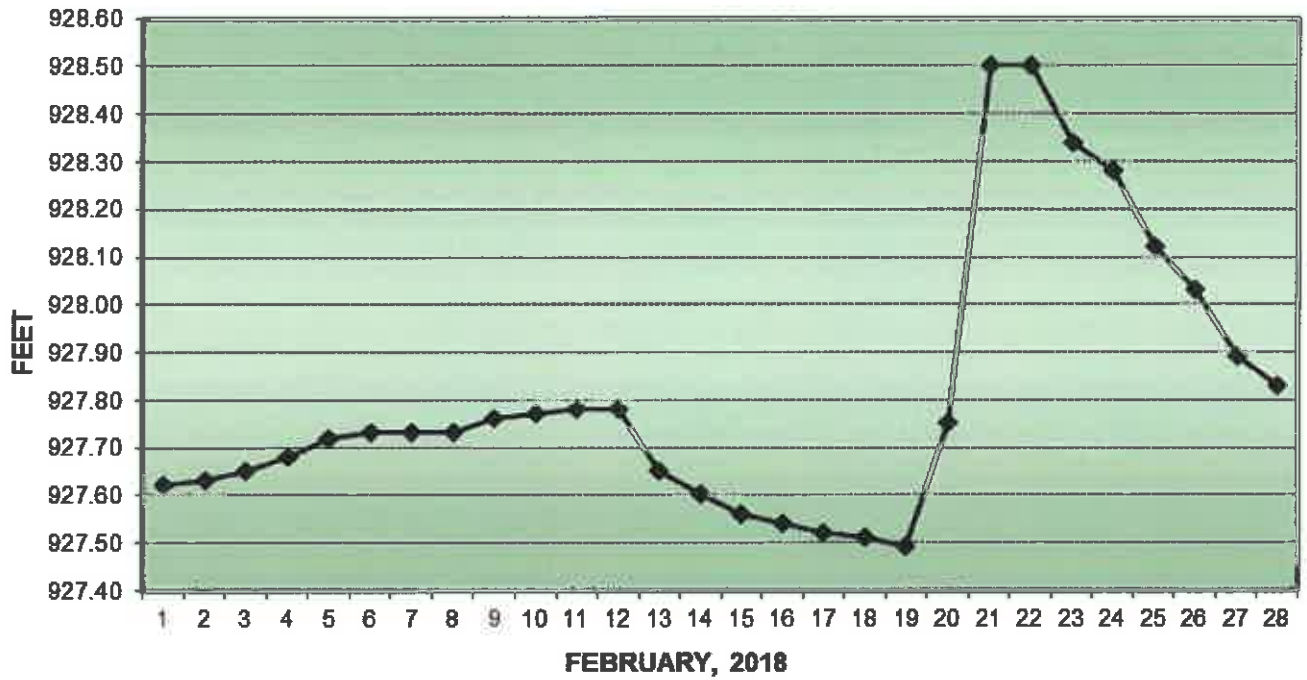
PRECIPITATION - DELAVAN LAKE, WI
