Pier Pick-up is available on 2nd and 4th Mondays in July and requests need to be made directly to DLSD to schedule crew.

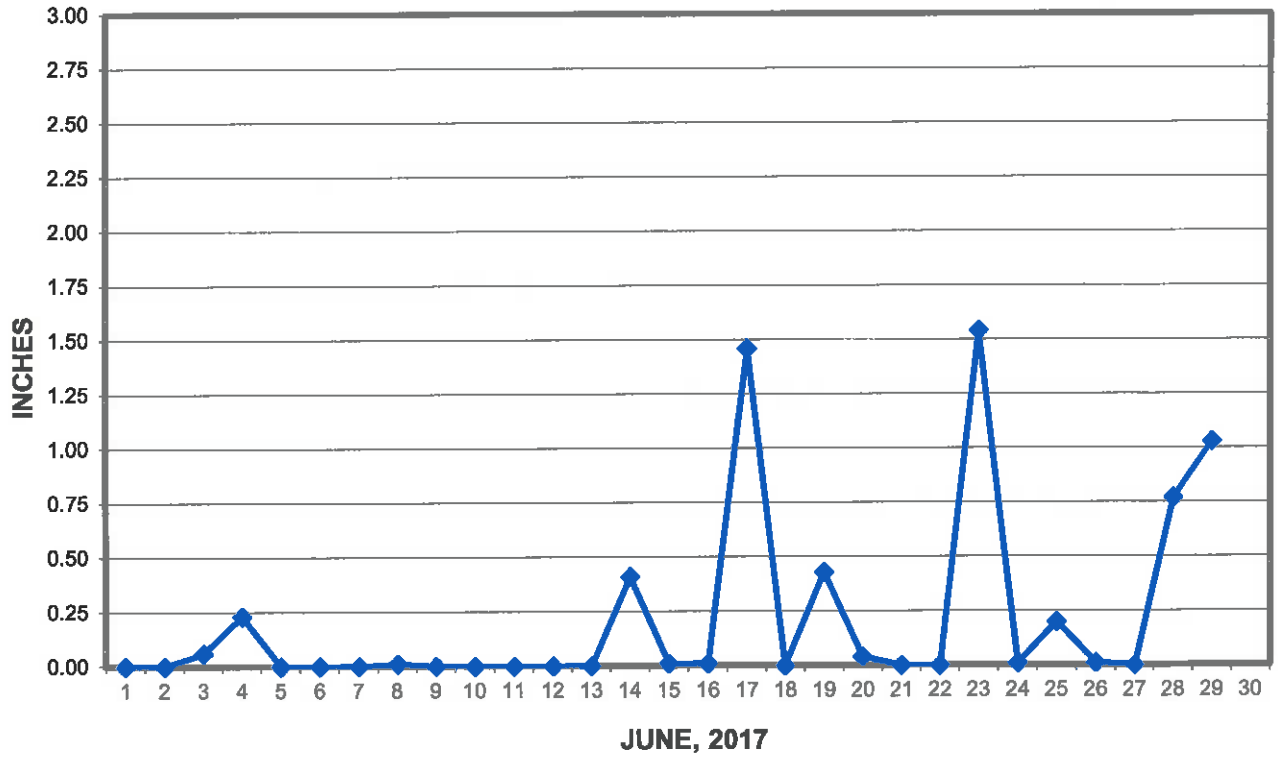
Lift Station #9 will be getting the gravel path resurfaced with porous pavers for storm water management and lake protection. DLSD public parking area will also get resurfaced with a combination of porous pavers and asphalt.

Lift Station #2 will be going thru a rehab of the pumps and electrical system. Alliant is making a request to have us off the Delta 3 phase system and install a WYE (grounded) system.

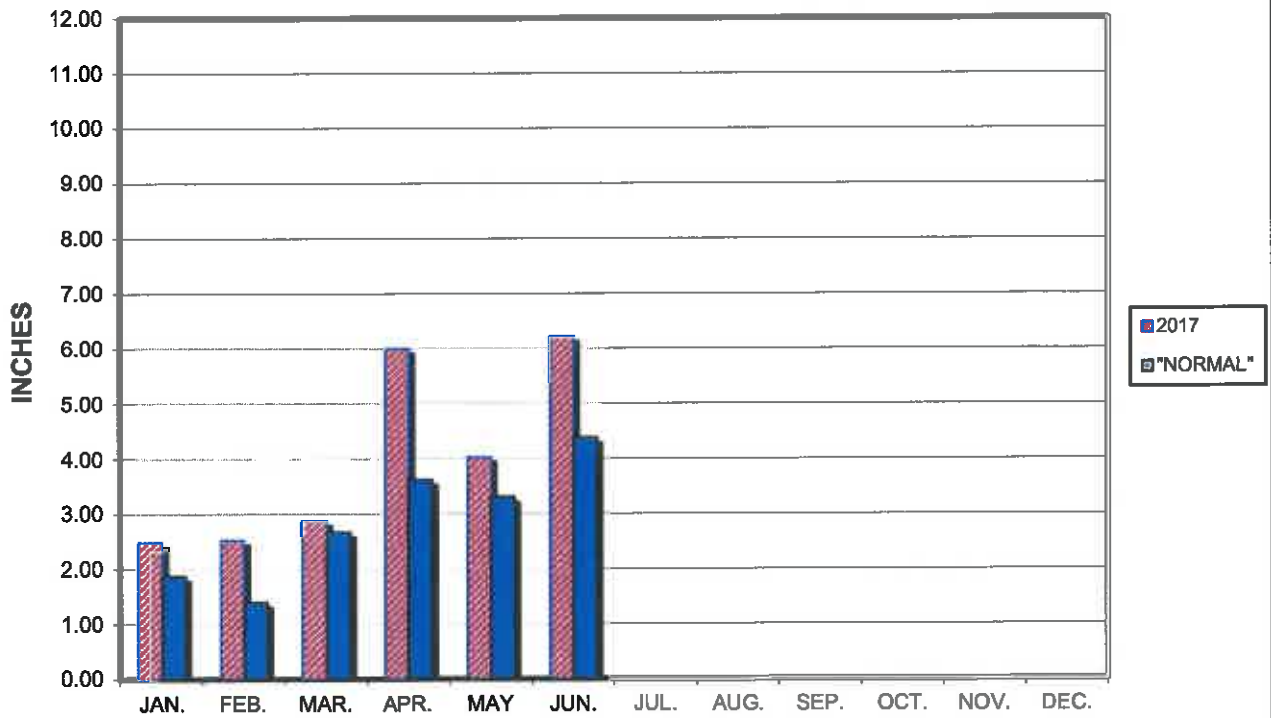
Pellets and Floc Logs were installed in various locations (Brown's channel and inlet) as test sites to study effects.

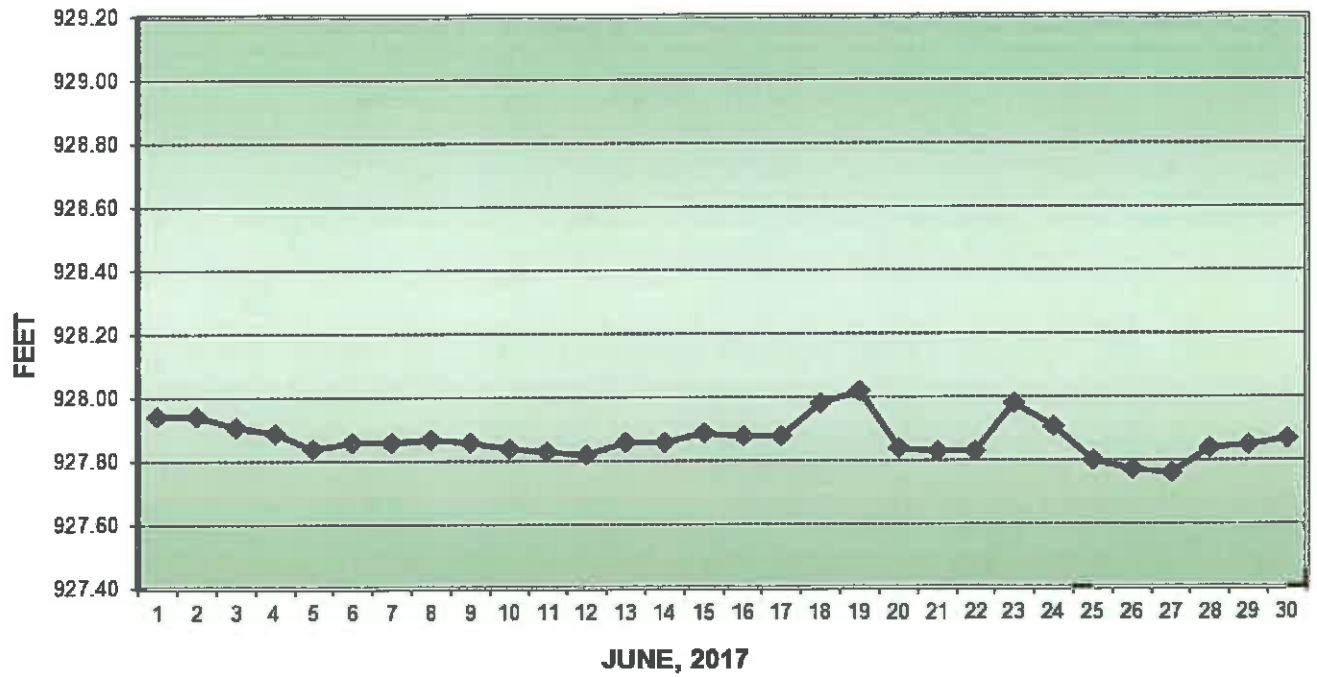
PRECIPITATION - DELAVAN LAKE, WI
